However, residents in attendance raised several issues with Council, including: the status of the sewer levy and why it was continuing, grass cutting and trimming the hedges on the golf course, drainage plans for 4th Street. Mayor Louis Belland and Council responded to the issues that were raised.

DELEGATIONS

Ray Kronewitt spoke to Council to raise a number of concerns for the Village. He spoke about cars that are parking along the ditches and grassed areas, making it difficult for traffic to get by and the concern regarding emergency vehicle access, the care and attention to the yards, with a lack of community pride. He suggested that the Village initiate some kind of promotion to instill community pride. Mr. Kronewitt also spoke to the issue of quads and

other off highway vehicles travelling through the village with under-aged operators and disregard for traffic laws, unsafe and unsightly properties that could also be a health risk. Mayor Louis Belland responded to his questions and thanked him for bringing his comments and concerns to Council.
