

BYLAW NO. 114

SUMMER VILLAGE OF ROSS HAVEN, ALBERTA

A By-Law of the Summer Village of Ross Haven, in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of regulating the use and development of land and buildings within the municipal boundaries.

WHEREAS, THE Planning Act, being Chapter P-9 Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980, and amendments thereto, Section 68, subsection 2, authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact a by-law to regulate the use and development of land and buildings.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Ross Haven, repeals any prior Zoning, Development Control and Land Use By-Laws and, on the date of the final passage of this By-Law, hereby enacts the Summer Village of Ross Haven Land Use By-Law No. 114.

READ A FIRST TIME IN COUNCIL THIS 13 day of December 1990 A.D.

READ A SECOND TIME IN COUNCIL THIS 12th day of April 1991 A.D.

READ A THIRD TIME IN COUNCIL AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 12th DAY

OF April 1991 A.D.
