BYLAW NO. 128

SUMMER VILLAGE OF ROSS HAVEN

This is a Bylaw of the Summer Village of Ross Haven, in the Province of Alberta, to authorize the execution of a Master Agreement between the Summer Village of Ross Haven and other municipalities for the establishment of an Intermunicipal Service Agency.

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act allows a municipality to enter into an agreement with other municipalities for the performance of any matter or thing judged to be of benefit to them: and

WHEREAS the Summer Village of Ross Haven considers it beneficial to enter into an agreement with other municipalities for the provision of land use planning, subdivision processing and associated services:

THEREFORE the Council of the Summer Village of Ross Haven in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enact as follows:

- 1. The Master Agreement establishing a joint municipal agency to be known as the NEW ERA AGREEMENT, a copy of which is attached hereto, is hereby ratified and approved: and the Mayor and the Municipal Administrator are hereby authorized to execute the said agreement for and on behalf of the Summer Village of Ross Haven.
- This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon third reading.
