

BYLAW NO. 139

SUMMER VILLAGE OF ROSS HAVEN

This is a Bylaw of the Summer Village of Ross Haven, in the Province of Alberta, to authorize:

1. The provisioning of Provincial E9-1-1 Service to all local Subscribers within the Summer Village of Ross Haven.
2. Imposing the Call Answer Fee as defined in this agreement to all Local Subscribers.

The execution of;

- A. AGREEMENT TO PROVISION PROVINCIAL E9-1-1 SERVICE.
- B. AGREEMENT TO COLLECT MUNICIPAL CHARGES FOR PROVINCIAL E9-1-1 SERVICE.
- C. NOTICE PURSUANT TO THE AGREEMENT TO COLLECT MUNICIPAL CHARGES FOR PROVINCIAL E9-1-1 SERVICE.
- D. E9-1-1 CALL ANSWER SERVICES AGREEMENT.

between A.G.T. Ltd., Parkland County and the Summer Village of Ross Haven, shall all form part of this bylaw.

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act allows a municipality to enter into an agreement with other municipalities for the performance of any matter or thing judged to be of benefit to them: and

WHEREAS the Summer Village of Ross Haven considers it beneficial to enter into agreements with other municipalities for the provision of E9-1-1 Service.

THEREFORE the Council of the Summer Village of Ross Haven in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enact as follows:

1. The
 - A.) Agreement to Provision E9-1-1 Service.
 - B.) Agreement to Collect Municipal Charges for Provincial E9-1-1 Service.
 - C.) Notice Pursuant to the Agreement to Collect Municipal Charges for Provincial E9-1-1 Service.
 - D.) E9-1-1 Call Answer Services Agreement.to be known as the E9-1-1 Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto, is hereby ratified and approved: and the Mayor and the Municipal Administrator are hereby authorized to execute the said agreements for and on behalf of the Summer Village of Ross Haven.
2. This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon third reading.
