

BYLAW NO. 143

SUMMER VILLAGE OF ROSS HAVEN

This is a Bylaw of the Summer Village of Ross Haven, in the Province of Alberta, to charge a "Special Service Tax" on all parcels in the Summer Village of Ross Haven, for the year 1997.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, 1994, Chapter M26.1, R.S.A., section 382 up to and including 387, permits Council to pass a "Special Service Tax" bylaw to raise revenue to pay for a specific service or purpose, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Summer Village of Ross Haven, in the Province of Alberta, deems it fair and equitable to charge equally, all parcels as shown on the 1997 Assessment / Tax Roll of the Summer Village of Ross Haven, a "Special Service Tax", and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of Ambulance Service, Assessment Service, Fire Protection, Lighting, Grading, and Garbage Collection is \$38,600, and the number of parcels on the 1997 Assessment / Tax Roll is 238;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Ross Haven enacts as follows;

- The Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized and required to levy a "Special Service Tax" charge of \$162.18 on each parcel as shown on the 1997 Assessment / Tax Roll.
- The "Special Service Tax" is to be included on the 1997 Tax Notice. It is a debt due to the Summer Village of Ross Haven and payable by June 30th, 1997.

THAT, this bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the third reading and passing thereof.
