## **BYLAW NO. 155**

## SUMMER VILLAGE OF ROSS HAVEN

This is a Bylaw of the Summer Village of Ross Haven, in the Province of Alberta, to authorize the Council of the Summer Village of Ross Haven to undertake and complete the Parkins Avenue Upgrading Project.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Summer Village of Ross Haven has decided to issue a by-law pursuant to Section 382 of the Municipal Government Act to authorize A 'Paving Tax' for the Parkins Avenue Upgrading Project.

The Summer Village of Ross Haven has made plans, specifications and estimates for the project and confirms the total cost of the said project will not exceed \$130,180.00.

The Council of the Summer Village of Ross Haven has estimated the following grant will be received and applied to the project.

1. Alberta Transportation and Utilities

\$90,800.00

In order to construct and complete the said project, it will be necessary for the Summer Village of Ross Haven to issue a special paving tax to collect a sum not to exceed \$39,380.00 on the terms and conditions referred to in this By-Law.

All required approvals for the project have been obtained and the project is in compliance with all acts and regulations of the Province of Alberta

The Council of the Summer Village of Ross Haven has given proper notice of intention to undertake and complete the construction of the Parkins Avenue Upgrading Project, the costs thereof to be assessed against all benefiting owners in accordance with the attached Schedule "A".

THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF ROSS HAVEN DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That for the purpose of the Parkins Avenue Upgrading Project the sum not to exceed Thirty Nine Thousand Three Hundred and Eighty Dollars (\$39,380.00) is to be paid by the property owners at large and is to be collected by way of a special paving tax as herein provided in attached Schedule "A".
- 2. During the year of construction of the project, there is hereby imposed on all property owners a special paving tax sufficient to cover the cost of said work. The said special assessment shall be in addition to all other rates and taxes.

THAT, this bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the third reading and passing thereof.
