

BYLAW NO. 159

SUMMER VILLAGE OF ROSS HAVEN

This is a Bylaw of the Summer Village of Ross Haven, in the Province of Alberta, to impose penalties on unpaid taxes, for the year 2000.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, 1994, Chapter M26.1, R.S.A., section 344 and 345, permits Council to pass a bylaw to impose a penalty on unpaid taxes, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Summer Village of Ross Haven, in the Province of Alberta, deems it expedient to impose penalties on unpaid taxes, and

WHEREAS, the Taxes in the Summer Village of Ross Haven are due and payable by June 30, 2000, for the year in which they were levied;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Ross Haven enacts as follows;

- The Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized and required to levy an 18% penalty on all outstanding taxes not paid by June 30, 2000, for the year in which they were levied, on July 1, 2000.
- The Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized and required to levy a further 18% penalty on all outstanding taxes not paid by December 31, 2000, for the year they were levied, on January 1, 2001, and an additional 18% penalty semi-annually, each succeeding year thereafter, so long as the taxes remain unpaid.

THAT, this bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the third reading and passing thereof.

THAT, upon passing of this Bylaw, Bylaw No. 152 is repealed.

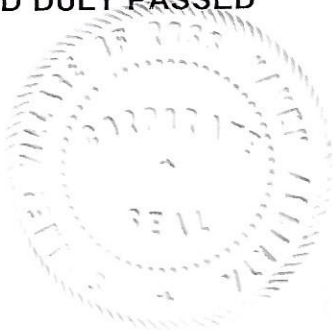
