

BYLAW NO. 181

SUMMER VILLAGE OF ROSS HAVEN

This is a Bylaw of the Summer Village of Ross Haven, in the Province of Alberta, to charge a "Special Tax" on all parcels in the Summer Village of Ross Haven, for the year 2004.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, 1994, Chapter M26.1, R.S.A., section 382 up to and including 387, permits Council to pass a "Special Tax" bylaw to raise revenue to pay for a specific service or purpose, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Summer Village of Ross Haven, in the Province of Alberta, deems it fair and equitable to charge equally, all parcels as shown on the 2004 Assessment / Tax Roll of the Summer Village of Ross Haven, a "Special Tax", and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of Road Repair & Maintenance, Ambulance Service, Fire Protection, and Recreation Service is \$ 61,281.00, and the number of parcels on the 2004 Assessment / Tax Roll is 237;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Ross Haven enacts as follows;

- The Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized and required to levy a "Special Tax" charge of \$258.57 on each parcel as shown on the 2004 Assessment / Tax Roll.
- The "Special Tax" is to be included on the 2004 Tax Notice. It is a debt due to the Summer Village of Ross Haven and payable by June 30th, 2004.

THAT, this bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the third reading and passing thereof.
