15. When, in the opinion of the person or persons declaring the state of local emergency, an emergency no longer exists in relation to which the declaration was made, they shall, by

resolution, terminate the declaration.

16. A declaration of a state of local emergency is considered terminated and ceases to be of any force

or effect when

(a) a resolution is passed under Section 15;

(b) a period of seven days has lapsed since it was declared, unless it is renewed by resolution;

(c) the Lieutenant Governor in Council makes an order for a state of emergency under the

Act, relating to the same area; or

(d) the Minister cancels the state of local emergency.

17. When a declaration of a state of local emergency has been terminated, the person or persons who

made the declaration shall cause the details of the termination to be published immediately by

such means of communication considered most likely to notify the population of the area

affected.

This Bylaw comes into force on the day it is finally passed.
