

# BYLAW NO. 255-14

## SUMMER VILLAGE OF ROSS HAVEN

**NOW THEREFORE**, under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, the Council of the Summer Village of Ross Haven, in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. That the Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to levy the following rates of taxation on the assessed value of all property as shown on the assessment roll of the Summer Village of Ross Haven:

2. That the minimum amount payable as property tax on residential property for general municipal purposes shall be nine hundred fifty dollars (\$950.00).
3. That a penalty of eighteen percent (18%) shall be added on all current (2014) unpaid taxes remaining unpaid after June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2014, and shall be added on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014.
4. That a penalty of eighteen percent (18%) shall be added on to all outstanding taxes and related costs that remain unpaid after December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2014, and shall be added on January 1, 2015.

**THAT**, this bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the third reading and passing thereof.


