Residential Solid Waste Pick-up Policy

Approved by Council September 12, 2006

Policy Statement

The Summer Village of Ross Haven would like regulate the residential solid waste container type and the amount of residential waste per lot per week.

Reason for Policy

The Summer Village of Ross Haven has deemed it necessary to regulate the type of container used for solid waste because of waste being spread around by dogs and wild animals.

The Summer Village of Ross Haven has deemed it necessary to regulate the amount of waste per lot per week, as it is evident that some residents are bringing waste from other locations, and having the Village dispose of it.

Related Information

The Summer Village of Ross Haven only picks up household waste. Any other types of waste will not be picked up.

The type of container to be used is one of metal or heavy plastic, with a lockable lid to prevent animals from getting into it.

All household waste must be placed in green garbage bags and then placed into the metal or plastic waste container with a lockable lid. The maximum weight of each bag is forty five (45) pounds. The maximum amount of waste per lot per week is four (4) bags.

Responsibilities

It will be the responsibility of the Maintenance Supervisor to refuse to pick-up any waste which is;

1. not in a proper container
2. not in green garbage bags
3. exceeding 45 pounds per bag
4. exceeding the maximum of 4 bags

Broken glass and sharp objects must be placed in a cardboard box, identified and placed beside the container for pick up.

It will be the responsibility of the Maintenance Supervisor to decide whether or not to pick-up the refused materials and if so must charge the property owner accordingly for services such as a special pick-up fee, a delivery trip to the landfill fee, or any landfill charges involved.
