

CONFEDERACY OF TREATY SIX FIRST NATIONS

The Confederacy of Treaty Six First Nations (CT6FN) was created in the Spring of 1993 to serve as the united political voice for affiliated Treaty No. 6 Nations for the continued protection of the fundamental Treaty, Inherent and Human Rights of the Treaty Peoples of our Nations. CT6FN is dedicated to ensuring that the terms, spirit and intent of Treaty No. 6 are honoured and respected. The right of the Treaty No. 6 First Nations to self-dtermination must be honoured and respected.

TREATY NO. 6 HISTORY

Treaty No. 6 was entered into on August 23, 1876 in Fort Carlton on September 9, 1876 and in Fort Pitt with adhesions from 1877-1950. Treaty No. 6 is an international Treaty entered into with the Crown of Great Britain. Provisions in the Treaty recognize the Medicine Chest Clause, Famine and Pestilence Clause as well as the rights to Health, Education; and other Treaty and Inherent Rights.

Treaty First Nations Peoples have Inherent Rights which include but are not limited to:

- The Right to Self-Determination which includes, governance and establishing other institutions
- The Right to jurisdiction and authority to enact laws
- The Right to protect and preserve our lands, resources and water
- The Right to the preserve our languages, practice our cultural customs and ceremonies
- The Right to the hunt, fish, trap and gather


